

Point of Care Assessment



- 1.** A point-of-care assessment is a series of questions to ask yourself about the person in care, environment, the task and you, as the care giver.
- 2.** This quick, informal check-in reminds you to observe both the person for signs of escalation and the environment for potential risk.
- 3.** Employers have a responsibility to support the use of a point of a care assessment by sharing it with staff, and providing instructions on what to do if risks are identified.
