

In addition to using the appropriate Personal Protect Equipment (PPE), frequent **handwashing** (using soap and water for at least 20 seconds) and respiratory hygiene (directing coughs/sneezes into your sleeve) should always be performed.

Social distancing by maintaining a distance of 2 meters or 6 feet should be applied at all times, when PPE is not required so as to limit the ability of the virus to spread
