The shortage of personal protective equipment (PPE) available to healthcare professionals has become increasingly problematic as COVID-19 cases continue to surge. Polymershapes has entered into a license agreement with MIT to make available low-cost, mass-produced disposable face shields exclusively for healthcare professionals, using the design engineered by MIT Project Manus.

With a one-piece, ships flat design, hospitals can rapidly distribute these protective face shields to staff. Once boxes of these flat sheets arrive at hospitals, healthcare professionals can fold them into three dimensional face shields in just 90 seconds before adjusting them to properly fit their face. They can then be staged at locations for pick up within hospitals.

- Low-cost disposable design
- 1-piece shield that ships flat
- Quick assembly to 3D shield
- Extra protection flaps, above and below face
- Adjustable up & down positions
- Crystal-clear plastic
