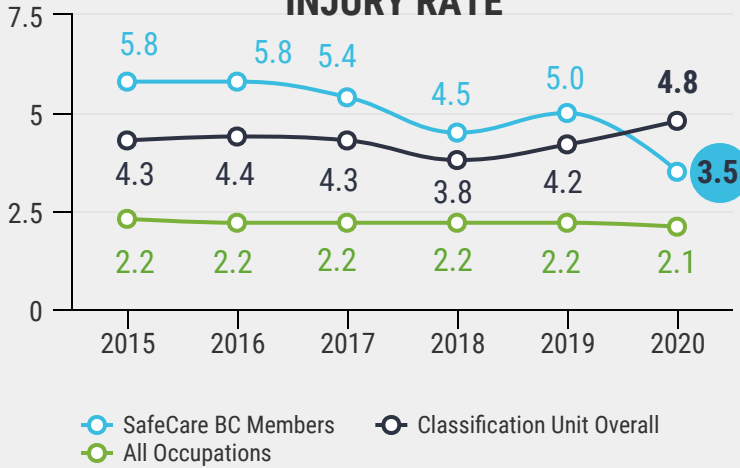

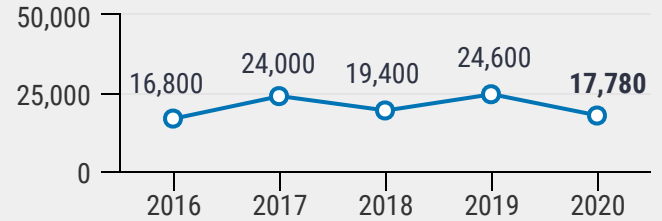

INJURY RATE

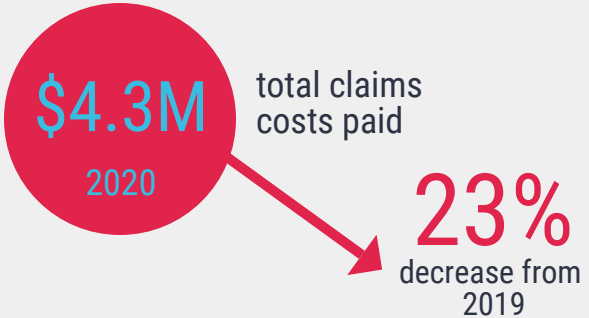


SafeCare BC's home and community care members showed a 30% decrease in workplace injuries in 2020, compared to the year previous. This is the lowest rate in more than a decade. This positive result contrasts with the sector overall, which saw an increase in injuries.

WORKDAYS LOST TO INJURY



17,780 workdays lost to injury in 2020 is the lowest in four years. **This is the equivalent of losing 71 full-time staff.**

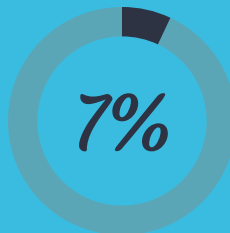


Did you Know?

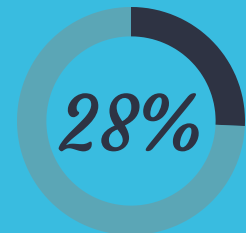
Having an effective Return/Recover at Work program supports people in their recovery, decreases staffing shortages, and decreases claims costs.
